LEAD GROUNDSKEEPER

GENERAL DESCRIPTION:

The lead groundskeeper position will assist and execute in the daily grounds and maintenance operations of Ripley Park. This independent worker directed by the Parks, Recreation, and Youth Director will complete functions that assist in the quality and overall appearance of the park during the season.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

The following duties are normal for this position. These are not to be construed as exclusive or all-inclusive; other duties may be required and assigned.

- Assist in supervision and training of seasonal grounds and maintenance staff
- Operate vehicles and park equipment
- Trimming/mowing and removal of brush, limbs and saplings
- General cleanup of the park, beach, restrooms, grills, and shelters
- Perform general maintenance duties including minor plumbing and electrical.
- Assist with assembling/takedown of seasonal Holiday Lights displays
- Work occasional mornings, nights, holidays, and weekends to meet needs of park and shelter rentals.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Red Cross certification in CPR and First Aid is desired.
- The following knowledge, experience and skills desired :
 - Basic knowledge of small engines
 - Knowledge of tractor and mower operations
 - General equipment maintenance (i.e. changing oil, greasing joints, sharpening blades, etc.)
 - Basic knowledge of home use insecticides and weed killers
- Must be able to work independently
- Must be motivated and have a positive attitude

WORK CONDITIONS & PHYSICAL REQUIREMENT:

- Employee is regularly exposed to outside weather conditions during all phases of the park season.
- Ability to obtain a valid driver's license from the State of Wisconsin.

Hours and Dates: Position is an hourly paid position at \$15.00 per hour depending on qualifications and experience. This position is seasonal approximately from March 1 to December 1 annually.
