

## **CAP Directors Report**

*March 2019*

### **Adult Athletics**

Endure Bootcamp and Jazzercise continued to run strongly through March. Pilates ran three classes during the month with 5 participants at each class. Our new program, Get Golf Ready “FORE” Adults starts late April and numbers are looking strong.

### **Aquatics**

21 members renewed or purchased passes/memberships in the month of March. Pool Deck Yoga wrapped up its first session on March 21 and it proved a success. Session 2 kicked off April 4 with 16 participants (14 registered, 2 drop-in). The NMS physical education classes completed their swimming unit in March. The Underwater Egg Hunt will take place again on April 18 from 6-8 pm. The Easter Bunny has the event on his calendar and is planning on hopping by for a bit.

### **CAP CARE**

In March, CAP CARE hosted their annual bake sale and raised over \$500. The funds will be used to purchase additional art supplies for the program.

CAP CARE hosted Spring break camp with 17 children enrolled. The highlight of the week was a trip to the Cambridge pool, Skyzone, and a scavenger hunt through town. The kids visited 10 local businesses to find a clue that they were hiding. They even got to go inside the vault at Badger Bank.

Miss Mandy completed her Leadership Credential and the first class of the Administrator credential in March. This is quite an accomplishment and took a lot of hard work. Congratulations to Mandy!

### **Community Café**

The Community Cafe was hosted by the London, Rockdale & Presbyterian Church of Oakland-Cambridge in March and served 223 individuals a delicious dinner of sloppy joes, salad and dessert.

### **Food Pantry**

The Food Pantry served 112 households to which included 192 adults and 86 children in the month of March. 77 Blue Jay backpacks were distributed in March as well. Nancy is working hard at establishing a small food pantry over at the high school for students to access. Plans are coming along nicely.

### **Ripley Park**

Staff recruitment was the main focus for Ripley Park in the month of March. Jordan has reached out to past employees and is working on setting up interviews with potential new employees. Park clean up will begin in early April.

### **Seniors**

The senior meal in March was held at the Presbyterian Church of Oakland-Cambridge to which 28 seniors enjoyed corn beef, cabbage, red potatoes and dessert while playing Bingo.

### **Youth Athletics**

Karate has become a staple within the youth athletics programs and continues to run steady each session. Baseball open gym started halfway through March with 3 dates and fifteen athletes attending each one. Planning for soccer, baseball, and softball were well underway in March. Numbers are great for all three programs.

### **Youth Center**

March was a huge month for the youth center as the Dream Big remodel took place over spring break! With the help of the CAP staff, Youth Center staff, and volunteers the Youth Center was transformed in the matter of 4 days. The kids are very excited with the new furniture and really enjoy the new sectional. A grand reopening will be scheduled in May once the final items have been received.

### **Youth Enrichment**

The March Parent's Night Out had a record of 17 kids participate as a joint pool party was hosted with the Youth Center. First Friends began its new format in March with a Monday/Wednesday offering as well as the normal Tuesday/Thursday. The Tuesday/Thursday maxed out with 16 kids and the Monday/Wednesday had 6 kids enrolled. CAP also introduced two new enrichment programs in March, Introduction to Drums & Percussion and Guitar lessons. Both classes are running well and the kids are enjoying them.

### **Other Information**

Planning for CAP's next special events are underway included the CAP hosted Community Café (May 2), Touch-A-Truck (May 11), the Lake Ripley Ride (July 27) and the Try Cambridge Tri (August 18).
